Re: Per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances

Per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances, or PFAS (also commonly referred to as forever chemicals) pose significant health and environmental concerns due to their bio-persistence and bio-accumulative properties.

The use of PFAS has been regulated internationally by the Stockholm Convention on Persistent Organic Pollutants since 2009, with some jurisdictions, such as the United Kingdom, the European Union and Australia, planning further reductions and phase-outs.

Autoglym can confirm that, through an ongoing program of formulation evaluation, no PFAS are included in any of the products.
